Stitch Guide and Notes

(US Terms)



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Difficulty: Advanced Beginner

Size: 157.5 cm x 157.5 cm / 62" x 62"



Materials needed:

- 4 mm (G) size hook (*I used [Furls Pink Odyssey](#)*)
- Stylecraft Special DK in the following shades and quantities:

Wisteria (C1):	100 g	(295 m/322 yards)
Cream (C2):	400 g	(1180 m/1288 yards)
Clematis (C3):	110 g	(324,5 m/354 yards)
Blush (C4):	100 g	(295 m/322 yards)
Candyfloss (C5):	165 g	(487 m/531 yards)
Apricot (C6):	200 g	(590 m/644 yards)
Lemon (C7):	200 g	(590 m/644 yards)

Total: 1275 g

Total yardage: approx. 3761,5 meters/4105 yards

- Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional)
- **NOTE: Blocking is essential to enhance the lacy, textured patternwork of your blanket**

Stitches Used and Abbreviations:

MR = magic ring

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

CH = chain

SK = skip

ST/STS= stitch/ stitches

SC = single crochet

SC2tog = single crochet two together

HDC = half double crochet

FPHDC = front post half double crochet

BPHDC = back post half double crochet

DC = double crochet

FPDC = front post double crochet

BPDC = back post double crochet

DC3tog = 3 double crochets together

FPTR = front post treble crochet

Puff ST = puff stitch



3DCCL = 3 double crochet cluster

V ST= V stitch

Cluster V ST = 3 double crochet cluster V stitch

- =repeat pattern between these symbols (*This is only used for a full repeat, may contain smaller repeats*)

{ } =indicates how many stitches go into the same stitch or used to repeat a small set of instructions between these brackets the number of times given

[] = used to repeat a medium length set of instructions between these brackets, the number of times given

[] = used to repeat a longer set of instructions between these brackets, the number of times given

Special Stitches:

Single Crochet Two Together (SC2tog):

Insert hook in given stitch/space, yarn over, pull through and leave the stitch unfinished. Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

Front Post Half Double Crochet (FPHDC):

Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over, and finish your half double crochet as usual.

Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC):

Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your double crochet as usual.

Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC):

Yarn over, insert your hook from back to front around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your double crochet as usual.

Puff Stitch (Puff ST):

Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a long loop through that stitch (*3 loops on hook*)

Yarn over hook again and insert hook into the same stitch, pull up a loop (*same height as the previous one*) twice more. You should have 7 loops on your hook.

Yarn over and pull through 6 loops, (*2 loops remain on your hook*), yarn over and pull through both remaining loops.

(this way, you will only have 1 loop on top of the puff stitches, instead of 2)



3 Double Crochet Cluster (3DCCL):

1. Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. *(2 loops on hook)*
2. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. *(3 loops on hook)*
3. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull, through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

V Stitch (V ST):

Double crochet in indicated stitch/space, chain 2, double crochet in same stitch.

Cluster V ST (Cluster V ST):

3 DCCL in indicated stitch/space, chain 2, 3 DCCL in same stitch/space.

Double Crochet 3 together (DC3tog):

1. Yarn over, insert hook into given stitch/space, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished (2 loops on hook)
2. Yarn over, insert hook into next indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished (3 loops on hook),
3. Yarn over, insert hook into next indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull, through all 4 loops.

Front Post Treble Crochet (FPTR):

Yarn over twice, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish treble crochet as usual.

Gauge: 4 DC STS and 2 rows = 1" / 2.5 cm



Additional notes:

- If a row/round starts with a Chain 1 or 2, this is not counted as a stitch, unless stated otherwise.
- Slip stitches do not count as stitches.
- CH 3 always counts as double crochet.
- **US terms** used throughout
- At the end of every round, there's going to be a note with the stitch count, so you can keep track of your work easily and avoid any mistakes. It's written in a different **color**; the first line in **bold** is always the total stitch count for the round. Below that, I included a stitch count per side (*excluding corner stitches*) and per corner too, in case you prefer it that way.
- When working on the corners, **always remember** that there might be a *hidden stitch* hiding under the corner stitches which is the first stitch of the previous row
- *Notes are written in a different color in (brackets) to help you through the pattern.*
- *You can start each round as I did in the pattern or you can use a standing stitch or chains, it's totally up to you!*
