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# *Mythia*

## *Stitch Guide and Notes*

*(US Terms)*



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**Difficulty:** Intermediate/Advanced

**Finished Size:** 70.5" x 70.5" / 180 x 180 cm AFTER BLOCKING

**Materials needed:**

- 3.75 mm (F) size hook (*I used [Rose Gold+White Odyssey by Furls](#)*)
- **Scheepjes Stone Washed** (*sport weight yarn*) in the following shades and quantities:
  - Citrine-817: 2 skeins (260 metres/284 yards) (C1)
  - Morganite-834: 4 skeins (520 metres/568 yards) (C2)
  - Turquoise-824: 9 skeins (1170 metres/1280 yards) (C3)
  - Fosterite-826: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C4)
  - Tourmaline-836: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C5)
  - Peridot-827: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C6)
  - Coral-816: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C7)
  - Beryl-833: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C8)
  - Blue Apatite-805: 4 skeins (520 metres/568 yards) (C9)
  - Rose Quartz-820: 4 skeins (520 metres/568 yards) (C10)
  - Carnelian-823: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C11)
  - Rhodocrosite-835: 3 skeins (390 metres/426 yards) (C12)

**Total: 44 skeins (2200 grams)**

**Total yardage: approx. 5720 metres/ 6255 yards**

**You can use fingering or DK weight yarn instead but that's going to affect the yarn quantities needed and note that the finished size of the blanket will be different.**

- Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (*optional*)
- **NOTE: Blocking is essential to enhance the lacy, textured patternwork of your blanket**

MR = magic ring

CH = chain

SK = skip

SM = stitch marker

ST/STS= stitch/ stitches

SP = space

SLST = slip stitch

SC = single crochet

SCBLO = single crochet back loop only

SC2tog = single crochet 2 together

BPSC = back post single crochet

HDC = half double crochet



FP HDC = front post half double crochet

BPHDC = back post half double crochet

DC = double crochet

BPDC = back post double crochet

FPDC = front post double crochet

FPDC3tog = front post double crochet 3 together

ExtFPDC = extended front post double crochet

2DCCL = 2 double crochet cluster

## *Special Stitches*

**Single crochet back loop only (SCBLO):**

Insert your hook only into the back loop on top instead of both loops, yarn over and finish your single crochet as usual.

**Single Crochet Two Together (SC2tog):**

Insert hook in given stitch/space, yarn over, pull through and leave the stitch unfinished. Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

**Back Post Single Crochet (BPSC):**





Insert your hook from back to front around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your single crochet as usual.

**Front Post Half Double Crochet (FPHDC):**

Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your half double crochet as usual.

**Back Post Half Double Crochet (BPHDC):**

Yarn over, insert your hook from back to front around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your half double crochet as usual.

**Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC):**

Yarn over, insert your hook from back to front around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your double crochet as usual.

**Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC):**

Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your double crochet as usual.

**Front Post Double Crochet 3 Together (FPDC3tog):**

1. Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. *(2 loops on hook)*
2. Yarn over, insert hook from front to back around the post of next stitch, from right to left, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. *(3 loops on hook)*
3. Yarn over, insert hook from front to back around the post of next stitch, from right to left, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through all 4 loops.

**Extended Front Post Double Crochet (ExtFPDC):**

Yarn over, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over, pull through 1 loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops.

**2 Double Crochet Cluster (2DCCL):**

1. Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. *(2 loops on hook)*
2. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.



### **3 Double Crochet Cluster (3DCCL):**

1. Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. (2 loops on hook)
2. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. (3 loops on hook)
3. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

### **4 Double Crochet Cluster (4DCCL):**

1. Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. (2 loops on hook)
2. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. (3 loops on hook)
3. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished. (4 loops on hook)
4. Yarn over, insert hook in same indicated stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through all 5 loops.

### **Front Post Treble Crochet (FPTR):**

Yarn over twice, insert your hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over and finish your treble crochet as usual.

### **2 Treble Crochet Cluster (2TRCL):**

1. Yarn over twice, insert hook into given stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished (2 loops on hook)
2. Yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.

### **3 Treble Crochet Cluster (3TRCL):**

3. Yarn over twice, insert hook into given stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished (2 loops on hook)
4. Yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, leave the stitch unfinished (3 loops on hook)

5. Yarn over twice, insert hook into same stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over pull through all 4 loops.

**Front Post Treble Crochet 2 together (FPTR2tog):**

1. Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back around the post of given stitch, from right to left, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops and leave the stitch unfinished.
2. Yarn over twice again, insert hook from front to back around the post of next given stitch, from right to left, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.

**Small Puff Stitch (SPuff ST):**

1. Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a long loop through that stitch (*3 loops on hook*)
2. Yarn over hook again, insert hook into the same stitch, pull up a loop (*same height as the previous one*) twice more. You should have 7 loops on your hook. (*Pic 1*)
3. Yarn over and pull through 6 loops. (*2 loops remain on your hook*) (*Pic 2*)
4. Yarn over and pull through both remaining loops. (*Pics 3-4*)

*(This way, you will only have 1 loop on top of the puff stitches, instead of 2)*

## Puff Stitch (*Puff ST*):

1. Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, pull up a long loop through that stitch (*3 loops on hook*)
2. Yarn over hook again, insert hook into the same stitch, pull up a loop (*same height as the previous one*) 3 more times. You should have 9 loops on your hook. (*Pic 1*)
3. Yarn over and pull through 8 loops, (*2 loops remain on your hook*) (*Pic 2*)
4. Yarn over and pull through both remaining loops. (*Pics 3-4*)

(*This way, you will only have 1 loop on top of the puff stitches, instead of 2*)

### Small Popcorn Stitch (*SPopcorn ST*):

Work 4 half double crochet (*HDC*) stitches in the same stitch (*Pic 1*). Drop the loop from your hook and insert your hook from front to back under the top 2 loops of the first half double crochet of the group (*Pic 2*). Grab the dropped loop with your hook, yarn over and pull it through the stitch, chain 1 to close (*Pics 3-5*). (*chain 1 doesn't count as a stitch*)

### Popcorn Stitch (*Popcorn ST*):

Work 5 double crochet (*DC*) stitches in the same stitch. Drop the loop from your hook and insert your hook from front to back under the top 2 loops of the first double crochet of the group. Grab the dropped loop with your hook and pull it through the stitch, chain 1 to close. (*chain 1 doesn't count as a stitch*)

### Bobble Stitch (*Bobble ST*):

1. Yarn over hook, insert hook in given stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through two loops and leave the stitch unfinished. (*2 loops on hook*)
2. Yarn over hook again, insert hook in same stitch/space, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through two loops and leave the stitch unfinished 6 more times. (*8 loops on hook*) (*Pic 1*)
3. Yarn over and pull through all 8 loops. (*Pic 2-3*)

### **V Stitch (V ST):**

Double crochet in indicated stitch/space, chain 2, double crochet in same stitch.

### **2 Double Crochet Cluster V Stitch (2DCCL V ST):**

Work 2 double crochet cluster, chain 2, 2 double crochet cluster in the same stitch.

### **3 Double Crochet Cluster V Stitch (3DCCL V ST):**

Work 3 double crochet cluster, chain 2, 3 double crochet cluster in the same stitch.

### **3 Treble Cluster V Stitch (3TRCL V ST):**

Work 3 treble cluster, chain 2, 3 treble cluster in the same stitch.

### **Small Picot Stitch (SPicot ST):**

Chain 3, slip stitch back into first chain.

### **Large Picot Stitch (LPicot ST):**

Chain 5, slip stitch back into the first chain.

**Gauge:** Not critical for this project but may affect the yarn quantities required.

**Additional notes:**

- If a row/round starts with a Chain 1, that is not counted as a stitch, unless stated otherwise.
- Slip stitches do not count as stitches.
- **US terms** used throughout.
- At the end of every round, there's going to be a note with the stitch count, so you can keep track of your work easily and avoid any mistakes. It's written in a different **color**; the first line in **bold** is always the total stitch count for the round *Starting with Round 34, this excludes corner stitches*. Below that, I included a stitch count per side (*excluding corner stitches*) and per corner too, in case you prefer it that way.
- When working on the corners, **always remember** that there might be a hidden stitch hiding under the corner stitches which is the first stitch of the previous row.
- *Notes are written in a different color in (brackets) to help you through the pattern or tell you which stitches to work into or skip.*
- *You can start each round as I did in the pattern or you can use a standing stitch or chains, it's totally up to you!*
